

Who makes up the Council?



30 elected representatives and 1 ex-officio member:

- Elected from wage, classified and admin faculty
- 1 ex-officio member appointed by the University President to serve as a liaison to the administration

Committees:

- Activities Committee—plan, coordinate, manage special events to promote staff morale and UMW spirit
- Communications Committee—create and maintain the S.A.C. website and other communication channels
- Election Committee—manage the election of members

- Being the *best public liberal arts university in the nation* means having open connections between staff, teaching faculty and UMW administration
- The S.A.C. was designed to be the bridge of communication between you and your co-workers, you and your supervisor, you and the UMW administration – on whatever level.
